To apply, please write a 250-500 word essay in which you address the following two questions:
Question 1: Why is it important to learn about the experiences and cultures of diverse peoples?
Question 2: In what ways will an ethnic studies minor help to advance your personal and academic goals?

The application essays will be evaluated according to their thoughtfulness as well as effort. *To renew the award for each academic year, a recipient must maintain the status of an Ethnic Studies minor and take at least one course in Ethnic Studies per academic year.*
